Laminate Care Guide

Our laminate wood

Just like our natural wood flooring, our laminate floors are designed to deliver lasting performance with minimal maintenance. With the right care, they will retain their appearance and durability for years to come.



Use protective pads on furniture

Attach protective pads to the feet of furniture to help prevent scratches and surface wear.



Lift furniture, don't drag

Always lift furniture when moving it. Dragging can damage the surface and affect the finish.



Use castor protectors

Castor protectors help distribute weight evenly and reduce the risk of dents or marks.



Protect high-traffic areas

Use mats or rugs in entrances and busy areas to reduce wear and prevent dirt being carried through the home.



Treat spills immediately

Wipe up any spills or moisture straight away using a microfibre cloth or dry mop to protect the integrity of the flooring.

TOP TIPS

Avoid excess water

Do not use a soaking wet mop, as excess moisture can cause warping and allow water to seep into the underlayers.

Act quickly

The sooner a spill is treated, the easier it is to prevent damage.

Lift, don't drag

Always lift furniture to prevent scratches and dents.

Avoid

abrasive materials

Never use scouring pads or harsh cleaning tools, as these can damage the finish.

Use the right tools

Sweep with a soft brush or vacuum using a hard floor attachment to avoid scratching the surface.
